## 2025-2026 Legislative Session Lobbyist Ethics Course Requirement

California Government Code Section 86103 requires that lobbyists attend an ethics course once during each 2-year legislative session and certify the completion date with the Secretary of State, Political Reform Division as a condition of registration to lobby in California. The Senate Committee on Legislative Ethics and the Assembly Legislative Ethics Committee jointly conduct these courses.

Know Your Ethics Deadlines: It is the responsibility of each lobbyist to obtain the course schedule, to sign up, attend the course as required, and certify the ethics completion date with the office of the Secretary of State's Political Reform Division by the specified compliance deadline. Amended Form 604's will no longer be provided at the ethics course as done in previous Sessions. (See Form 604 instructions for filing requirements and compliance deadlines https://prd.cdn.sos.ca.gov/forms/form-604.pdf.)

You will receive the Zoom invite the Monday prior to the Ethics Course. Please register upon receipt of the Zoom invite. To secure enrollment in an ethics course, submit a completed sign-up form accompanied with a \$50 check or money order as indicated below. You may email <a href="Stacey.medlock@sen.ca.gov">Stacey.medlock@sen.ca.gov</a> to confirm enrollment after submitting sign-up form and fee. Committee Staff will contact you if the course you have selected is at capacity.

There is no provision for waiver of the ethics course requirement or for extension of the ethics completion deadline; nor is there a provision for an extension of a lobbyist's deadline to certify his/her ethics completion date by filing the required amended Form 604 (Lobbyist Certification Statement) with the office of the Secretary of State (see Form 604 instructions page). Non-filers are referred to the Fair Political Practices Commission for non-compliance.

<u>MCLE CREDIT</u>: The Assembly Legislative Ethics Committee and the Senate Committee on Legislative Ethics are State Bar of California MCLE approved providers. This activity is approved for 1.5 hours MCLE credit, but <u>no MCLE credit</u> will be offered on the following subjects: (1) Legal Ethics; (2) Elimination of Bias; or (3) Competence Issues. Appropriate forms will be available at the course for attorneys who seek MCLE credit.
